## Joint Meeting of BACA and EACA 4<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> July 2017 at the University of Warwick

The Summer Scientific Meeting will be held at the University of Warwick (UK) from 4<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> July 2017 and is hosted by Professor Richard Tunstall. The conference will run from 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> July 2017, with an optional postgraduate course running on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2017. The postgraduate course will take place in the West Midlands Surgical Training Centre (UHCW Hospital, Coventry) and provides opportunity to explore the anatomy and practice of a range of interventional and surgical procedures using fresh cadaveric material.

The University of Warwick is a campus university located 5 miles from the city of Coventry. All conference activities will take place on the campus and a range of bed-and breakfast accommodation is available on-site on a first come-first served basis.
